- 1. REMAND *Department of Finance, State Water Resources Control Board, and California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region v. Commission on State Mandates and County of San Diego, et al.* Sacramento County Superior Court, Case No. 34-2010-80000604 Third District Court of Appeal, Case No. C070357**  
*Discharge of Stormwater Runoff*, 07-TC-09 (California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region Order No. R9-2007-001)

On February 6, 2020, the Sacramento County Superior Court issued an Order denying the petition and cross-petition, and affirming the Commission's decision, finding that the sections of the permit pled imposed a new program or higher level of service, and except for the activities related to the Hydromodification Management Plan (in Part D.1.g. of Order No. R9-2007-001) and Low Impact Development (parts D.1.d.(7) & D.1.d.(8) of Order No. R9-2007-001), the activities resulted in increased costs mandated by the state. The parties are in the process of preparing the Judgment.
