## STATEMENT OF DECISION

On January 8, 2010, claimant requested withdrawal of the severed portion of the test claim titled *School Accountability Report Cards IV* (01-TC-22A). Claimant's request was served in writing, and a sixty-day notice of this withdrawal and dismissal was issued pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 2, section 1183.08.

No interested parties objected to the claimant's request for withdrawal, or took over the claim by substitution of the parties, on or before March 9, 2010.

## CONCLUSION

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the severed portion of the test claim titled *School Accountability Report Cards IV* (01-TC-22A), is dismissed, without prejudice, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 2, section 1183.08.

Any claimant may file a new test claim on the above-referenced test claim legislation. However, any such claim shall be subject to a new filing date and to the statute of limitations pursuant to Government Code section 17551.
