Please provide clarification regarding footnote 9 on page 10 of the test claim that reads as follows:

The State Board of Education has proposed regulations for the high school exit examination (attached as Exhibit D). The Board proposes to add sections 1200 – 1216 to Title 5, Chapter 2, Division 1 of the California Code of Regulations. These proposed regulations may include additional reimbursable activities not claimed in this test claim. The claimant will amend the test claim filing to include any activities upon adoption of the Board's regulations.



The regulations cited in footnote 9 were adopted in July 2001, but the Commission has no record of an amendment being filed for this test claim. Therefore, please notify the Commission in writing within two weeks of the date of this letter whether you intend to amend test claim 00-TC-06, *High School Exit Examinations*. Please direct your response to Eric Feller, Commission Counsel, and provide a copy of your response to the current mailing list. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 118.1.2, subd. (b).) Any amendment to the test claim must conform to Commission filing requirements, (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 1183, subds. (e) & (f).) The Department of Finance and affected state agencies will be given an opportunity to comment before an analysis is prepared. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 1183.02, subd. (b).)

This matter, which is currently set for hearing on March 27, 2003, is being taken off calendar, and will be heard at a later date. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 1183.01, subd. (c)(3).)
