The Department of Finance (Finance) requests an extension to respond to the Commission staff's draft analysis of the parameters and guidelines on the Interagency Child Abuse and Neglect Investigation Reports (00-TC-22) mandate program until June 7, 2013. Additionally, we request the postponement of this item in the May hearing. The complexity of the changes of statutes since the adoption of the statement of decision and associated issues are requiring more time than we contemplated combined with a very hectic legislative-budgetary process schedule.
