REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND**

On behalf of the test claimants, I am requesting an extension of time to respond to the June 3, 2011, Draft Staff Analysis from June 24, 2011 to July 5, 2011. The due date for claimant action on several Commission cases for which I am the claimant representative have coincided into a short response period after years of pending status at the Commission:

1. The Employment of Faculty response to the DSA due June 28, 2011
2. The Habitual Truant DSA on the RRM due June 30, 2011
3. The proposed parameters and guidelines for Minimum Conditions for State Aid due June 30, 2011.
