The State Controller's Office reviewed the proposed parameters and guidelines for the Parental Involvement Programs drafted by your office. Below are our comments and recommendations. Proposed additions are underlined as follows:

**I. SUMMARY OF THE MANDATE**

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On December 7, 2012, the Commission on State Mandates (Commission) adopted a statement of decision on the test claim finding that Education Code sections 11504, 49091.10(a), 49091.10(b), 51101(b), and 51101.1(a), as added or amended by the test claims statutes...

**COMMENT:** Please add Education Code section 49091.10(a) since it is cited as the first reimbursable activity in the Ongoing Activities section.

**II. ELIGIBLE CLAIMANTS**

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Charter schools are not eligible to claim reimbursement.

**COMMENT:** Please add this sentence at the end of the paragraph. This is similar to the language in the proposed parameters and guidelines for the Behavioral Intervention Plans program.
