The Department of Finance (Finance) requests a sixty-day extension to respond to the Water Conservation Act of 2009 (10-TC-12) test claim. The requested additional time is necessary due to the complexity of issues pertinent to four individual parties included in the test claim and the development of a coordinated response with the Department of Water Resources. Further, Finance staff involved in this effort, have conflicting duties relative to the development and information requests regarding the 2013 Governor's Budget. Finance will submit responses to the Commission on State Mandates on or before April 7, 2013.


