REBUTTAL TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE'S COMMENTS RECOMMENDING REJECTION OF THE COUNTY'S SB 958 TEST CLAIM

The County of Los Angeles (County) has reviewed the comments filed by the Department of Finance (Finance) and respectfully requests that the Commission on State Mandates accept the County's late filed rebuttal for consideration.

Finance erroneously states that the costs claimed in Test Claim 19-TC-04 did not create a new program or higher level of service. Prior to the passage of Senate Bill 958 (SB 958), the County was not obligated to create a commission for the purpose of redistricting. SB 958 enacted statutes that required the County to create a 14-member "Citizens Redistricting Commission" (Commission) and established strict requirements, which are only applicable to the County, for the applicants to the Commission and for the Commission's operations (see Elections Code § 21530 et seq.). But for SB 958, the County would have the option of not forming a redistricting commission at all or forming an advisory, independent, or hybrid redistricting commission. Furthermore, the legislative history to SB 958 acknowledged findings as to the "necessity of a special statute for the unique circumstances facing the County for Los Angeles." (Legislative Counsel's Digest, approved by Governor September 28, 2016. Filed with the Secretary of State September 28, 2016.)

The cases cited by Finance are not applicable to this Test Claim. In *City of Anaheim v. State of California* (1987) 189 Cal. App. 3d 1478, the court agreed that there was no mandate because the legislation in question did not compel the City of Anaheim to do anything or constitute a "program" or "service." However, unlike in the *City of Anaheim* case, SB 958 does not increase costs of an existing program and instead it creates an entirely new program. Furthermore, this Test Claim is distinguishable from the claim in the *City of Anaheim* case because the Legislative Counsel's Digest, which was approved by the Governor, states that by "increasing the duties on local officials, the bill (SB 958) would impose a state-mandated local program."

The other case cited by Finance was *San Diego Unified School District v. Commission on State Mandates* (2004) 33 Cal.4th 859, in which the court ruled that reimbursement is not required if a statute merely implements a change that increases the cost of providing a service. This case is not analogous as SB 958 did not implement a change, but rather created an entirely new system of redistricting for the County, which includes the creation of an independent 14-member Commission (see Elections Code § 21532). For the first time, the County is responsible for creating a new application and review process for the Commission, including informing the public about the Commission and the application process, receiving applications for membership on the Commission, reviewing those applications, and eliminating applicants who do not meet the specified qualifications (see Elections Code § 21532(e)).

The County is also required to select 60 of the most-qualified applicants from the applicant pool, publish the names of the 60 selected applicants for at least 30 days, create a subpool of applicants for each of the five supervisorial districts, conduct a random drawing to select the first eight (8) members of the Commission, and ensure that the entire 14-member Commission was created no later than December 31, 2020 and in each year ending in the number zero thereafter (see Elections Code § 21532(a), (f), (g)).

Once the Commission is created, the County is obligated to support its activities, including providing reasonable staffing and funding, and ensure that a complete and accurate computerized database is available for redistricting (Elections Code § 21534.)

Failure to recognize the statutorily-imposed costs of SB 958 would allow the State to impose a program on the County without providing funding as per the California Constitution, Article XIII B, Section 6. Accordingly, the Commission on State Mandates should grant the County's Test Claim since SB 958 mandates a new program unique to the County and no bars to reimbursement apply.
