As requested in your letter of December 2, 1999, the Department of Finance has reviewed the test claim submitted by the Western Placer Unified School District (claimant) asking the Commission to determine whether specified costs incurred under Chapter 828, Statues of 1999, (AB 631, Migden), are reimbursable State mandated costs (Claim No. CSM-99-TC-05, "Charter School Collective Bargaining"). However, we have concluded that we are unable to provide a recommendation of the merits of the request by January 2, 2000. This letter constitutes our request for a 60-day extension of time for good cause. We believe that the following factor satisfies the "good cause" criterion in Section 1181.1 (g) of the Commission's regulations: the individual responsible for preparing the document has other time-limited commitments during the affected period, specifically, preparing the Governor's Budget for the January 10 constitutional deadline.
