ADOPTION OF PROPOSED 2018 RULEMAKING CALENDAR

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Background

Government Code section 11017.6 requires covered state agencies to prepare an annual rulemaking calendar for publication in the California Regulatory Notice Register. While the Commission is exempt from review and approval by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), it has traditionally submitted the calendar to keep the public informed of its rulemaking plans. The calendar is due to OAL before February 12, 2018.

Proposed 2018 Rulemaking Calendar

The attached proposed 2018 Rulemaking Calendar consists of one rulemaking:

Order 18-01: General Cleanup Provisions

This rulemaking would amend Title 2, Chapter 2.5, Articles 1 through 10 to provide general cleanup to the Commission's regulations.
