## Eligible Claimants

School districts and county offices of education.

## Basis For Mandate

The Commission on State Mandates determined that Education Code section 46601 requires school districts and county offices of education to provide a notification and appeal due process for interdistrict attendance permit applicants. Education Code sections 46601.5, and 48204, subdivision (f), require school districts to consider the request for an interdistrict attendance permit to facilitate the child care needs of the pupil and to ensure that the application is not denied or revoked for arbitrary or impermissible reasons.

## Statewide Cost Estimate

The Commission adopted a statewide cost estimate of \$4,398,000 for fiscal years 1992-93 through 1996-97.
