Mr. Burdick,

The Commission on State Mandates adopted its statement of decision on this test claim in July 2007. Thus, proposed parameters and guidelines were due on August 31, 2007. Nothing was filed. On March 30, 2008, CSM notified the County of Alameda, claimant (letter to Allan Burdick) that it had failed to comply with the requirements of Government Code section 17557, subdivision (a). Thus, the county's reimbursement claim would be subject to a 20% penalty for the first twelve months of incurred costs.

Please advise if the County of Alameda has abandoned this claim, if another county will be added as co-claimant, or if the County has designated a new representative and failed to notify the Commission.
