Commission staff has reviewed this filing and determined that it is incomplete under Government Code section 17553 because all the content requirements for a test claim filing have not been met. The specific sections that remain incomplete are as follows:

- The actual increased costs incurred by the claimant during fiscal year for which the claim was filed to implement the alleged mandate.<sup>1</sup>
- The actual or estimated annual costs that will be incurred by the claimant to implement the alleged mandate during the fiscal year immediately following the fiscal year for which the claim was filed.<sup>2</sup>
- A statewide cost estimate of increased costs that all local agencies or school districts will incur to implement the alleged mandate during the fiscal year immediately following the fiscal year for which the claim was filed.<sup>3</sup>

- Identification of all of the following:
  - i. Dedicated state funds appropriated for this program.
  - ii. Dedicated federal funds appropriated for this program.
  - iii. Other nonlocal agency funds dedicated for this program.
  - iv. The local agency's general purpose funds for this program.
  - v. Fee authority to offset the costs of this program.<sup>4</sup>
- Declarations under penalty of perjury, based on the declarant's personal knowledge, information, or belief, and signed by persons who are authorized and competent to do so (A) to support actual or estimated increased costs that will be incurred by the claimant to implement the alleged mandate; (B) to identify all local, state, or federal funds, or fee authority that may be used to offset the increased costs that will be incurred by the claimant to implement the alleged mandate, including direct and indirect costs; and (C) to describe new activities performed to implement specified provisions of the new statute or executive order alleged to impose a reimbursable state-mandated program.<sup>5</sup>
- Identification of prior mandate determinations made by the Commission on State Mandates or a predecessor agency that may be related to the alleged mandate.<sup>6</sup>
- A copy of the statute or executive order alleged to impose a mandate.<sup>7</sup>

To complete the filing, the claimant must complete the above-mentioned requirements. If the test claim filing is not completed within 30 days of the date of this letter, the executive director may disallow the original test claim filing date (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 1183, subd. (g)).
