Dear Ms. Halsey:

The State Controller's Office (SCO) requests a one-month extension—from November 1, 2013, to December 2, 2013—to respond to the draft proposed amendment to the parameters and guidelines and statement of decision related to the *Crime Statistics Reports for the Department of Justice Program* issued October 11, 2013.

As indicated in our previous extension request, the Commission on State Mandates' staff analyzed various complex issues related to four separate mandate programs, adopted statement of decisions, and statutory provisions. The SCO is unable to complete the analysis by November 1, 2013, due to the complexities of the proposal and existing priorities. The additional one-month extension should allow the SCO sufficient time to thoroughly analyze the legal aspect of the issues and offer additional language to clarify reimbursable activities. Based on our previous analysis, the statewide impact could be potentially \$159 million over eleven years. Please approve the additional one-month extension and the resulting postponement of the hearing date—from December 6, 2013, to January 24, 2014—for good cause.
