Dear Mr. Petersen:

We have reviewed the *Tuition Fee Waivers* Test Claim filing and we are drafting the staff analysis. In order to complete the pending draft staff analysis, Commission staff needs updated face sheets identifying which Registers have been plead and are part of the test claim.

In this test claim, several sections of title 5 regulations have been plead and copies of regulations that were current at the time the test claim was filed were attached as supporting documentation. The face sheet and opening pages of the test claim identify specific code sections and statutes, and sections of title 5 regulations, and Revised Guidelines and Information, "Exemption from Nonresident Tuition," Chancellor of the California Community Colleges (May 2002).

Copies of the code sections, statutes, and current set of title 5 regulations, and the Chancellor's publication are included in the test claim filing. However, no Registers are identified on the original test claim face sheet since at that time there was no requirement to identify Registers.

Last year, the Commission received a supplement to this claim which consists of histories of the Title 5 CCR sections that were originally plead and copies of Registers that pre-dated, added, amended, or repealed the sections included in the original test claim. However, since none of these registers are identified in the original filing, staff is unable to determine exactly which version of Title 5 CCR sections (as added or amended by a specific Register) has been plead and should be analyzed.
