On January 5, 2012, the Commission on State Mandates (Commission) received the claimant's request to withdraw the test claim filed on the above-named matter.

Section 1183.08 of the Commission's regulations requires the Commission to post the notice of withdrawal on its website for 60 days in order to provide other claimants the opportunity to take over the claim. If no other claimant takes over the claim, the executive director may dismiss it.
