The Commission on State Mandates received your notice that claimant and Department of Finance are no longer jointly developing a reasonable reimbursement methodology for this program pursuant to Government Code section 17557.1. Pursuant to Government Code section 17557, claimant is now proposing a reasonable reimbursement methodology for inclusion in the proposed parameters and guidelines that were issued on October 10, 2006. The revised proposed parameters and guidelines and proposed reasonable reimbursement methodology are complete.

Review and Comments. All state agencies and interested parties in receipt of this letter are invited to comment on the revised proposed parameters and guidelines and proposed reasonable reimbursement methodology. Recommendations and comments must be submitted to the Commission by **July 8, 2010**. The claimant and interested parties may file rebuttals with the Commission by **August 7, 2010**. The claimant, state agencies, and interested parties are required to submit an original and two (2) copies of written responses or rebuttals to the Commission and to simultaneously serve copies on the test claimant, state agencies, and interested parties on the mailing list.

Hearing. If requested, Commission staff will conduct a prehearing conference. A hearing on this matter will be set when the record closes.
