Dear Ms. Halsey:

This office represents co-claimants County of Orange and Orange County Flood Control District with respect to the above-referenced test claim 09-TC-03 ("Test Claim"). On behalf my clients and all other Test Claim co-claimants, I am writing in response to the Notice of Incomplete Joint Test Claim Filing ("Notice"), dated November 18. Specifically, this letter addresses two alleged Test Claim deficiencies identified in the Notice: (1) that the test claim may not be timely, due to an alleged lack of assertion or evidence of when costs were first incurred under the stormwater permit ("Permit") which is the subject of the Test Claim; and (2) that the test claim lacks detailed costs incurred by the co-claimants.

While my clients and the other co-claimants respectfully reserve their right to object to the Notice on the ground that the Test claim was deemed complete by the Commission on July 9, 2010, the purpose of this letter is to direct the staff's attention to evidence already submitted in support of the Test Claim which, we believe, addresses the points set forth above, and to also propose a possible solution to the first issue regarding the timeliness of the claim.

If you and your staff do not agree that the information submitted with this letter addresses those two points, we then respectfully request an immediate conference with staff, the parties and any other interested parties to determine what further steps must be taken by the co-claimants to address the Notice. Time is of the essence, as the Notice provides a deadline of December 19, 2016 for the cure for the alleged deficiencies.

1. Alleged Untimeliness of Test Claim: As the Notice points out, Government Code section 17551, subdivision (c) provides that a test claim is timely if it is either filed “not later than 12 months following the effective date of a statute or executive order, or within 12 months of incurring increased costs as a result of a statute or executive order, whichever is later.” The Commission’s regulations define “within 12 months of incurring increased costs” to mean “by June 30 of the fiscal year following the fiscal year in which increased costs were first incurred by the test claimant.” Cal. Code Regs., tit 2, § 1183.1 (c).

As the Notice acknowledges, the Test Claim was filed on June 30, 2010. While this filing may have occurred more than 12 months after the Permit effective date of June 1, 2009, the evidence submitted with the Test Claim demonstrates that the Test Claim was timely filed “within 12 months of incurring increased costs.”

We direct your attention to several items, including Exhibit A to the Section 5 Narrative Statement, pages 120-22 of the Test Claim filing (for your convenience, a copy of these pages is attached). Exhibit A is incorporated into the text of the Narrative Statement and identifies the fiscal year in which costs first were incurred for certain mandates set forth in the permit, e.g., Fiscal Year (“FY”) 2009-10 or FY 2010-11. The declarations filed with the Test Claim also specifically set forth FY 2009-10 or FY 2010-11 as the first year in which costs were incurred. (The Declarations can be found on pages 173 to 313 of the Test Claim.) Since the end of FY 2009-10 is June 30, 2010 (the date on which the Test Claim was filed), the Test Claim not only was timely filed but was filed one year before the latest date in which it could have been filed.

In light of these facts, we are unclear as to why staff has determined that the Test Claim may be untimely. Even had costs first been incurred in FY 2008-09 (which ended only one month after the Permit’s effective date), the Test Claim would still be timely pursuant to the Commission’s regulations, because the Test Claim was filed by June 30 of the next fiscal year, i.e. by June 30 of the fiscal year following the very first fiscal year in which costs under the Permit could have been incurred.

Additionally, the Notice requests “evidence of the date and amount of costs first incurred as a result of the alleged new activities required under the order.” With respect, the Commission’s regulations on the issue of timeliness do not require evidence of the amount of first costs, only that a test claim be filed within 12 months following the effective date, or within 12 months of first incurring increased costs, whichever is later. Cal. Code Regs., tit 2, § 1183.1

(c). Both the Section 5 Narrative Statement (including Exhibit A thereto) and the Section 6 Declarations contain allegations and evidence that such increased costs were first incurred either in FY 2009-2010 or FY 2010-2011. Such evidence has already been provided, as set forth above.

Notwithstanding these points, and in an effort to promptly address staff's concerns, we understand that the issue of timeliness of the test claim also arose in test claim 14-TC-03, San Diego Water Permit, County of San Diego. We further understand that after consultation with staff, the test claimants there were allowed to cure the timeliness issue by including language in their Narrative Statement specifically setting forth the fiscal year during which costs were first incurred to comply with the mandates in that executive order. (Please see Section IV of the San Diego County Narrative Statement at 5-9, a copy of which is attached.) While the co-claimants do not believe that another averment is required to establish the timeliness of the Test Claim because the Narrative Statement and the Declarations already set forth the timing of first costs, we are able and willing to amend the Narrative Statement to add language similar to that in the San Diego County test claim if Commission staff determines that such language is necessary to deem the Test Claim timely.

We therefore respectfully request that staff either withdraw its determination of incompleteness with respect to the timeliness of the test claim or indicate that it would accept a modification of the Narrative Statement along the lines of that set forth in Section IV of the Narrative Statement for test claim 14-TC-03. If neither of these resolutions is acceptable, we respectfully request a conference to be held no later than December 2, 2016 to discuss what additional evidence is required of the co-claimants on this point. We understand and agree that such a conference be open to the parties and all interested parties.

2. Detailed Cost Estimates: With regard to the provision of detailed cost estimates, we have reviewed each of the Declarations filed in Section 6 of the Test Claim as well as Pages 121-122 of the test claim, which provide various cost estimates for the year in which costs were first incurred (FY 2009-10) and for the coming fiscal year (FY-2010-11). Our review indicates that while the Declarations do not contain cost estimates for all items in the Test Claim, estimates are provided for the majority of the items.

To reduce the burden on both the co-claimants and Commission staff and in light of fact that specific cost numbers have already been provided for numerous items in the Test Claim, we propose that the co-claimants file new declarations focusing only on items where no cost estimate was previously provided, so as to supplement the existing declarations. The Narrative Statement would also be modified to include cost estimates.
