Dear Mr. Keiner:

On September 9, 2019 the Grossmont Union High School District (claimant) filed a request with the Commission on State Mandates (Commission) for a 30-day extension to file comments on the Draft Proposed Decision, currently due on September 18, 2019, and for postponement of the November 22, 2019 hearing on the above-captioned Incorrect Reduction Claim (IRC).

Specifically, the claimant requires an extension of time to October 18, 2019 due to the voluminous record and the lengthy Draft Proposed Decision and that claimant counsel is involved with other competing litigation that conflict with the current deadlines. Although claimant includes reference to the State Controller's (Controller's) Late Comments on the IRC which were filed September 20, 2017 and served on claimant on September 21, 2017 (nearly two years ago) as an additional reason for the extension, the 30-day rebuttal period from the date of service of those comments has long since passed.

Nonetheless, section 1187.9(b) of the Commission's regulations provide that while postponements are disfavored and pursuant to Government Code section 17530, the executive director has a duty to expedite all matters before the Commission, a request for postponement filed by the claimant at least 15 days before the hearing shall be approved for good cause. (Cal. Code. Regs., tit. 2 § 1187.9(b).)

Therefore, the request for extension of time to file comments on the Draft Proposed Decision, and for postponement of hearing is approved for good cause pursuant to section 1187.9(a) and (b)(1)(F) and (b)(3)(A) of the Commission's regulations. Claimant's comments on the Draft Proposed Decision are now due **October 18, 2019** and this matter is now set for hearing on **January 25, 2019 January 24, 2020**.
