Dear Ms. Halsey:

Pursuant to 2 C.C.R. § 1187.9(a) and (b), and for the reasons set forth below, the County of San Diego respectfully requests a 30-day extension of time to May 15, 2019, within which to submit comments to the Draft Proposed Decision, as well as a continuance of the tentatively scheduled hearing from May 24, 2019 to the next regularly scheduled hearing on July 26, 2019.

Good cause for the extension of the deadline to provide comments and the postponement of the hearing exists for the following reasons:

- The Department of Finance's ("DOF") comments were due in this matter on February 11, 2019, but were not filed until March13, 2019. Pursuant to 2 C.C.R. § 1190.3, the County should have been allowed thirty days to provide rebuttal comments to the DOF's late comments, but instead, the Draft Proposed Decision issued less than 2 weeks later.
- Timothy Barry who has been handling this matter, and all other pending mandate matters on behalf of the County of San Diego, retired on March 14, 2019. I assumed responsibility for this matter and all other mandate matters on behalf of the County and I require additional time to familiarize myself with the claim and the legal issues raised therein. In addition to my other workload, I have been diligently working to familiarize myself with the record and the legal issues in the Sexually Violent Predators matter (CSM-4509), 12-MR-01, so that I can timely submit comments in that matter on the County's behalf by the April 10, 2019 due date. As a result, I have had very little time to devote to this matter and do not feel the April 15, 2019 deadline will allow me sufficient time to prepare comments on the County's behalf.

There has been no prior request for an extension of the hearing in this matter, and I am not aware of any manner in which an extension would prejudice any party. I attempted to contact the Department of Finance to determine if they would stipulate to an extension. They indicated they didn't have a position on the issue, but would go along with whatever the Commission decided was appropriate.

As set forth above, good cause exists to grant the requested extension of time to provide comments. In addition, good cause exists for a continuance of the scheduled hearing from May 24, 2019 to July 26, 2019. We therefore respectfully ask that you grant the request.
