#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On March 27, 2003, during the hearing on test claims 99-TC-13, Enrollment Fee Collection and 00-TC-15, Enrollment Fee Waivers, the claimant, Glendale Community College District, requested a withdrawal, without prejudice, of the Board of Governors Fee Waiver Program and Special Programs, 2000-2001 Program Manual. Claimant's request was made pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 2, section 1188.3.

Sixty-day notice of this withdrawal and dismissal was provided pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 2, section 1183.08. No interested party to this test claim has taken over the claim by substitution. Therefore, the issue before the Commission is whether to adopt the Proposed Statement of Decision, dismissing the Board of Governors Fee Waiver Program and Special Programs, 2000-2001 Program Manual from test claim 00-TC-15.<sup>2</sup>

#### Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Commission adopt the Proposed Statement of Decision, dismissing the above-named manual from the 00-TC-15 test claim.
