DECLARATION OF ADRIANA ATTEBERRY

I, Adriana Atteberry, do hereby declare as follows:

- 1. I am the Animal Services Supervisor for the Town of Apple Valley and have serviced in this capacity since October 24, 2017. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this Declaration, unless stated on information and belief, in which case, I believe the facts to be true. If so required, if called as a witness, I could and would testify to the statements made herein.
- 2. As part of my duties, I am responsible for assists in coordinating the work plan for the assigned staff; meets with staff to identify and resolve problems; ensures coverage of staff for all shifts and assignments; assigns work activities, projects, and programs; monitors work flow; reviews and evaluates service delivery, methods, and procedures; makes recommendations for improvement and ensures maximum effective service provision. Creates statistical reports, prepares and analyzes information in order to assess animal services operations.
- 3. During the audit, I worked with the State Controller's Office and responded to their requests for information. At the time, I provided the allocations of time spent by activity as the auditor requested. The original allocations I provided, before I was asked to reduce them to total to 100% between all classifications, were true and correct.
- 4. The two tables attached were prepared by the State Controller's Office. While we disagree with their percentages, the staffing information is accurate and shows that the Shelter was short staffed in FY 2008-09 in the Shelter Attendant positions. During that fiscal year, Kristin Hebertson (Hall) was requested to perform the duties of the Shelter Attendant, while we were recruit for this position. Therefore the 85%-time allocation we provided during the audit was correct.
- 5. However, during FY 2007-08, Kristin's time on general care and maintenance should have been 60%. The Registered Vet Technician was performing the animal care and maintenance in addition to her paraprofessional veterinary medical care (exam, treatments, health evaluations, vaccines) duties.

DECLARATION OF KRISTIN HALL

I, Kristin Hebertson (Hall), do hereby declare as follows:

I am the Veterinary Technician for the Town of Apple Valley. I have been employed by the Town in this capacity since September 11, 2006. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this Declaration, unless stated on information and belief, in which case, I believe the facts to be true. If so required, if called as a witness, I could and would testify to the statements made herein.

- 1) My main duties include providing paraprofessional veterinary medical care and treatment of animals as well as providing general care and maintenance to the animals.
- 2) During the audit, I was asked to provide a percentage of time spent only on care and maintenance.
- 3) The Shelter typically employs six Animal Shelter Attendant to provide care and maintenance services to the Town's animals. However, during Fiscal Year 2008-09 half of these positions were vacant, and I was required to absorb more of the general care and maintenance duties this year while we were short staffed. Therefore, it is my believe, that the 85% time provided at the time of the audit was an accurate reflection of time spent on these general care and maintenance activities.
- 4) However, I believe that this percentage for general care and maintenance should have more accurately been 60% during Fiscal Year 2007-08, when the Shelter Attendant positions were adequately staffed.

I am personally conversant with the foregoing facts and information presented in declaration and in this Incorrect Reduction Claim and if so required, I could and would testify to the statements made herein.
