INTRODUCTION

Commission on State Mandates

Article XIII B, section 6 of the California Constitution was approved in 1979 to require the state to reimburse local agencies and school districts for increased costs mandated by the state resulting from new statutes or executive orders passed by the California State Legislature, the Governor, or a state agency. To implement article XIII B, section 6, the Legislature created the Commission on State Mandates (Commission) to succeed the State Board of Control in making determinations whether new statutes or executive orders are state-mandated programs.¹ The Commission is also authorized to hear claims from local agencies and school districts that the State Controller has incorrectly reduced reimbursement claims.²

Report to the Director, Department of Finance

The annual Budget Act requires the Commission on State Mandates to report to the Director, Department of Finance on workload levels and backlog. The 2009 State Budget Act states:³

The Commission on State Mandates shall, on or before September 15, 2009, and annually thereafter, submit to the Director of Finance a report identifying the workload levels and any backlog for the staff of the commission.

Commission Workload

The Commission's test claim and incorrect reduction claim workload is backlogged.

Commission staff continually addresses the test claim backlog. We annually project how many test claims we will complete. We adjust these projections weekly. This is based on the following factors:

- The number and level of positions. The number of test claims completed is certainly based on the number of positions we have for a particular fiscal year, but also on the level of those positions. We have two staff counsel and one staff counsel III positions. All attorney positions complete test claims. However, a staff counsel III may also handle other workload, including litigation, which could reduce the time available to complete test claims.
- Complexity of the test claims. This is the most significant factor in determining how many test claims are completed each fiscal year. Test claims are often thought to be filed on one individual statute. This is not correct, especially when evaluating the backlog. Test claims are often filed on numerous statutes, regulations, and executive orders. For example, the 51 test claims filed in 2002 allege that nearly 500 statutes, and 400 regulatory sections and executive orders are mandated programs. By law, each statute, regulation, and executive order pled requires a finding by the Commission.
- Other workload. We must also factor in other workload, such as litigation, including remands from the court, and completion of parameters and guidelines and requests to amend parameters and guidelines.
- Number of Commission meetings. We also factor in how many meetings will be conducted for a particular fiscal year. The Commission is required by statute to conduct

at least six public meetings per year, and we tentatively schedule two additional meetings each year.

Eliminating the Incorrect Reduction Claim (IRC) Backlog

There are currently 148 IRCs pending before the Commission. Unlike test claims, there is no statutory deadline for completing the IRCs. In addition, the Commission is not staffed to complete the IRC workload. Nevertheless, Commission staff developed a workplan for completing the IRC workload that proposes the Commission begin hearing IRCs in July 2010 if the Commission is provided with additional staff. If the Commission is not provided with additional staff, the work plan proposes to complete the IRC workload as time and resources permit.

Budget Reductions

In 2008-2009, the Commission left one staff counsel III position vacant to reduce our General Fund operations budget by 1.5 percent, as ordered by Governor's Executive Order S-01-08. This position was eliminated in the 2009-2010 State Budget. This action will increase the time it takes to eliminate the pending workload. This leaves the Commission with 11 positions, including three staff attorney positions.

Following are tables identifying the Commission's overall pending workload, including separate tables showing test claim and incorrect reduction claim workload. The report also includes tables that show the Commission's elimination of workload.⁴
